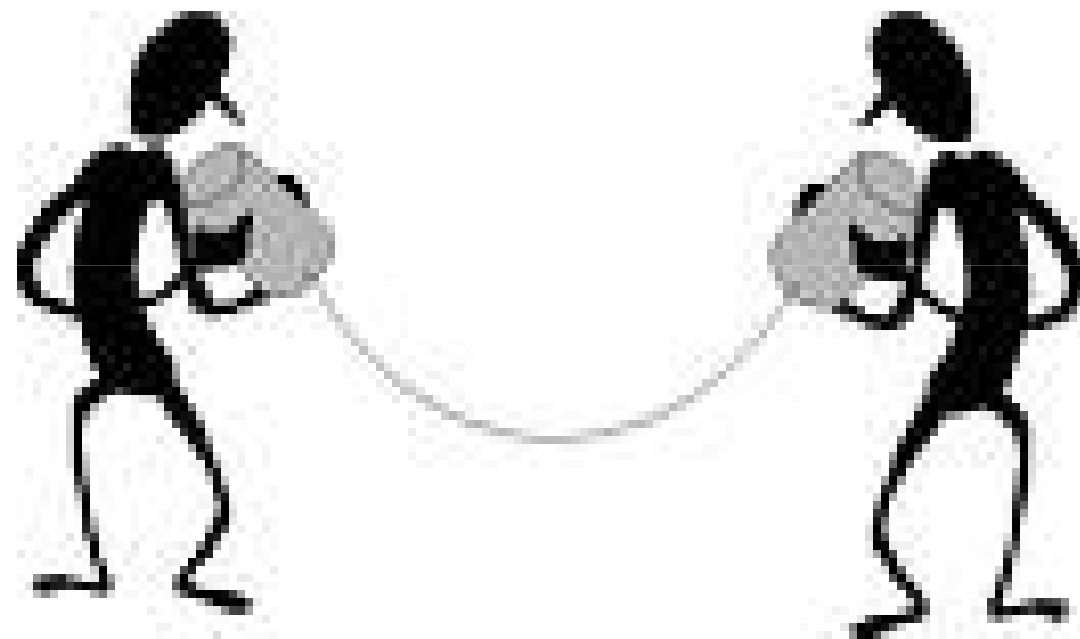
# Six on-going choices

1. Testing for and treating STIs before our next sex partner (or not)
2. Declining, deferring or dating potential new sex partners (or having a new sex partner)
3. Telling sex partners about our HIV and STI diagnoses (or not)
4. Monogamy (or sexually open relationship)
5. Non-penetrative sex (or intercourse)
6. Condoms (or bareback)

# The best sex life?

- Unconfident of already having gonorrhoea/syphilis
- Immediate sex with a new partner
- Silent sex
- Open relationships

# The best sex life?

- Confident of not having gonorrhoea/syphilis
- No sex, deferred or dated sex
- Discussed sex
- Monogamous relationship

# Better sex with less harm?

- Confident of not having gonorrhoea/syphilis  
OR unconfident of already having gonorrhoea/syphilis
- Declined, deferred, dated OR a new sex partner
- Discussed sex OR silent sex
- Monogamous relationship OR open relationships
