

Vital Statistics 2004 The UK Gay Men's Sex Survey

Scotland NHS Health Boards Data Report (March 2008)

This is a report of data from the UK Gay Men's Sex Survey 2004, conducted by Sigma Research in collaboration with health promoters throughout the UK. This report supplements the annual report *Risk and reflexion* (down-loadable from <http://www.sigmaresearch.org.uk/files/report2005c.pdf>). Survey methods and interpretation of the variables are outlined in that report. This data is intended to provide HIV health promotion planners with information about their local gay population. This report contains data from men who live in Scotland and for whom NHS Board of residence data is known. Respondents are grouped according to the NHS Health Board in which they live.

The data

The survey used three data collection methods over the summer of 2004:

- (1) A self-sealing, Freepost addressed booklet distributed by 113 health promotion agencies throughout the UK: (14 based in Scotland);
- (2) In English and Spanish on two specific web-sites <<http://www.sigmasurvey.org.uk>> and <http://www.sigmaspanish.org.uk>>, promoted via links on 37 gay and HIV related web-sites (1 targeting men living in Scotland specifically). Two sites, gay.com and gaydar.co.uk, conducted substantial paid for promotion of the survey.
- (3) As an insert in the GMFA magazine 'FS' which could be returned by Freepost.

This report contains data from all the men recruited through **all methods**.

The respondents are grouped according to the SHA they live in.

To be included in the sample respondents must:

- be male;
- be aged 14 or over;
- be living in Scotland;
- have had sex with a man in the last year and / or have a gay, bisexual or other "queer" identity;
- have completed at least one demographic question and one other question.

Differences between the number of surveys returned and the number of men who appear in the sample are due to these exclusions.

The tables

Groups of men living in the same NHS Board appear as a line in the tables. The bottom line of each table gives the result for the entire Scotland sample. The first table shows the number of men recruited to the survey living in each NHS Board and the size of the Sub-samples in the rest of the tables. Areas with fewer than 20 men are not reported on further. The tables show the proportions (%) of each sub-sample for that variable (less missing data). Rows (lines across) add up to 100%. The only exception to this layout is table 3, Age averages.

Questionnaires

The contents page identifies the Booklet question number (Q) each table is derived from.

Funding

The survey was funded by Terrence Higgins Trust as part of CHAPS, a national HIV prevention initiative funded by the English Department of Health and the National Assembly for Wales. Web

recruitment occurred in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. Booklet recruitment occurred in England Wales and Scotland.
