# Vital Statistics 2006 The UK Gay Men's Sex Survey

Area Sub-samples Data Report (February 2008) South West Strategic Health Authority

This report uses data from the UK Gay Men's Sex Survey 2006, conducted by Sigma Research in collaboration with health promoters throughout the UK. This report supplements the annual report (down-loadable from <a href="http://www.sigmaresearch.org.uk/files/report2008c.pdf">http://www.sigmaresearch.org.uk/files/report2008c.pdf</a>). Survey methods and interpretation of the variables will be outlined in that report. This data is intended to provide HIV health promotion planners with information about their local gay population. There is one data report for each of the Strategic Health Authority Areas in England. In each report men are usually grouped according to their local PCT of residence. The report indicates where this is not the case.

#### The data

The survey used two data collection methods over the summer of 2006:

- (1) A self-sealing, Freepost addressed booklet distributed by 76 health promotion agencies;
- (2) On a specific web-site < <a href="http://www.sigmasurvey.org.uk">http://www.sigmasurvey.org.uk</a>, promoted via links on 31 gay and HIV related web-sites. Two sites, gay.com and gaydar.co.uk, conducted substantial paid for promotion of the survey.

This report contains data from all the men recruited through **both methods**. The respondents are grouped according to the agency which recruited them. To be included in the sample respondents must:

- be male;
- be aged 14 or over;
- be living in the UK;
- have had sex with a man in the last year or have a gay, bisexual or other "queer" identity;
- have completed at least one demographic question and one other question.

Differences between the number of surveys returned and the number of men who appear in the sample are due to these exclusions.

#### The tables

Groups of men living in the same PCT area appear as a line in the tables. The bottom line of each table gives the result for the entire area being considered. The first table shows the number of men recruited to the survey living in PCT areas and the size of the Subsamples in the rest of the tables. PCT areas with fewer than 20 men and amalgamated PCT areas (where respondents cannot be allocated to an individual PCT area) are reported on further as "all other men". The tables show the proportions (%) of each sub-sample for that variable (less missing data). Rows (lines across add up to 100%. The only exception to this layout is table 3, Age averages.

#### Questionnaires

The contents page identifies the Booklet question number (Q) each table is derived from. The questionnaire used in the survey is available to download at: http://www.sigmaresearch.org.uk/files/VS2006booklet.pdf.

#### **Funding**

The survey was funded by Terrence Higgins Trust as part of CHAPS, a national HIV prevention initiative funded by the English Department of



Health and the National Assembly for Wales. Web recruitment occurred in England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland. Booklet recruitment occurred in England and Wales.

#### SAMPLE DESCRIPTION

- 1a. PCT area of residence.

- 3. Age averages; from Q7; the median age (line them up by size and pick the one in the middle), the minimum (youngest) and maximum (oldest) ages, the mean age (add them up and divide by how many there are), and the standard deviation (a measure of how spread out along the range they are).
- 4. Years of full-time education after the age of 16 years of age; Q8.
- 5. Sexual identity; Q6.
- 6. Ethnicity in six groups; from O9.
- 7. Living arrangements; Q10.
- 8. In a Civil Partnership or Marriage; Q15.

#### **HIV & Hepatitis C TESTING**

- 9. HIV testing history; Q18 + Q19 + Q20.
- 10. Hepatitis C testing history; Q25 + Q26.

#### **SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR**

- 11. Gender of sexual partner in the last year; Q28.
- 12. HIV concordancy of regular male relationship whether men have a regular partner and if so, whether they have the same (sero-concordant) or different (sero-discordant) HIV statuses, or don't know; Q11 + Q17.
- 13. Number of male sexual partners in the last year; Q29 (Those who had sex with men).
- 14. Anal intercourse and condom use in the last year; Q28 + Q30.

#### **HEALTH NEEDS**

- 15. HIV is still a very serious condition; 31a.
- 16. The sex I have is always as safe as I want it to be; Q31b.
- 17. I'd expect a man with HIV to tell me he was positive before we had sex; Q31c.
- 18. I'd know where to go if I wanted to make some new friends; Q39a.
- 19. I'd like more ways of meeting other Gay men that don't revolve around sex; Q39b.
- 20. I would like to be more involved in promoting the health of Gay and Bisexual men; Q39c.

#### **HEALTH NEEDS - HIV TRANSMISSION AND THE LAW**

- 21. Laws that can be used against the sexual behaviour of people with HIV are different in different countries; Q36a.
- 22. Some people with HIV have been imprisoned in the UK for passing their infection to a sexual partner; Q36b.
- 23. People with HIV have been imprisoned in the UK for passing their infection without intending to do so; Q36c.
- 24. No HIV positive person has been imprisoned in the UK for having sex with a negative person who did not get HIV; Q36d.
